STATE OF THE REGISTRY 2022–2023

The Anthony Nolan and NHS Stem Cell Registry Annual Data

The State of the Registry data is compiled by the members of the Anthony Nolan and NHS Stem Cell Registry (the 'aligned registry'). This data covers the period from April 2022 to March 2023. It outlines the collective work of the aligned registry to recruit stem cell donors; bank umbilical cord blood donations; and provide donor cells for UK transplant over this period.

The Anthony Nolan and NHS Stem Cell Registry is formed of Anthony Nolan, DKMS UK, NHS Blood and Transplant (NHSBT), and the Welsh Bone Marrow Donor Registry. The aligned registry partners collaborate to streamline and accelerate unrelated stem cell provision and to increase the availability of unrelated donors and cord blood units in the UK.

ALIGNED REGISTRY DEMOGRAPHICS 2022-2023

The aligned registry stands at over 2.3 million stem cell donors as of 31 March 2022. The cord blood bank stands at more than 28,000 searchable, clinical grade, cord blood units.













NEW DONORS MADE ACTIVE 2022–2023





STEM CELL PROVISION 2022–2023






