Thank you so much for putting on your event – every single person signed up to the register could be the answer someone's desperately waiting for.

Read on to find out how to get the best from your event!

When you encourage people to sign up to the register, you'll need to let them know:

- They'll stay on our register until they turn 61, but we'll only ask them to donate their stem cells when they're the best possible match for a patient in need.
- They could be asked to donate to a patient anywhere in the world, but the donation will always happen in the UK.
- The donation process will be completely anonymous.
- If they're a match, there are two ways they could be asked to donate – bone marrow or Peripheral Blood Stem Cell (PBSC). They need to be comfortable with both when they sign up.

When someone is ready to sign up, you need to give them:

- A set of three swabs.
- A labelled swab wallet.
- A freepost envelope.

Then they need to:

- Write their date of birth and initials on the back of the wallet.
- Scan the QR code on the front with their mobile phone and complete their application form.

Once they have submitted their form they need to:

- Write down their confirmation code on the back of their wallet.
- Swab their cheeks – there's a helpful video guiding them through this process on the completion page.
- Seal their wallet, place it in the freepost envelope, and pop it in any Royal Mail post box. It'll get sent straight to the Anthony Nolan labs to be processed.
