

**INFORMATION AND TERMS ABOUT VOLUNTEERING AT THE  
TCS LONDON MARATHON 2026 WITH ANTHONY NOLAN**

Volunteering at Anthony Nolan can involve, for example, cheering or greeting, taking photographs or being at our post race party.

1. You agree to volunteer at the 2026 TCS London Marathon entirely at your own risk and Anthony Nolan shall not be liable for any injury or loss which you may suffer or incur as a result of your volunteering at this event, unless such injury or loss is incurred as a result of Anthony Nolan's negligence.
2. Anthony Nolan takes all reasonable steps to minimise the risk of injury to volunteers at fundraising events and these are in addition to steps carried out by the external event organiser. There is a stringent risk assessment process in place for each event. However, by volunteering at the TCS London Marathon you acknowledge that there may be conditions or circumstances which are beyond Anthony Nolan's control and which can lead to unforeseen risks. 3. This event is organised by an external event organiser.
4. Anthony Nolan expects you to abide by the rules, instructions and regulations provided by Anthony Nolan's staff and contracted agencies, officials and police. These are in addition to those given by the external events organiser which you should also follow.
5. This role can involve standing for long periods of time in a variety of different weather conditions. If you are unsure of your physical ability to take part, you are asked to take medical advice from your doctor prior to the event day. It is your responsibility to ensure that you are medically fit to volunteer.
