

## YOUR LIFESAVING IMPACT

The impact of our volunteers' work really does save lives. The numbers below show just how amazing the achievements were in the 2014/15 financial year. We hope it inspires you to do even more amazing things!

Almost 2,000 people volunteered for us.

Our volunteers raised £158,000.

They delivered 855 bags of stem cells.

735 volunteers cheered our runners and cyclists and supported our fundraising events.

Our volunteers sent out 34,295 vital spit kits, sorted 15,000 saliva samples and inspired 28,475 people to join our register.
